

# Wonderful You “2-Step Stampin’ card

Sets(s): Wonderful You; Stems & Silhouettes jumbo roller wheel

## Accessories:

½ sheet of Kraft cardstock  
2 ¾ x 3 ¼ inch Kraft cardstock  
4 x 5 ¼ inch Brocade Blue cardstock  
2 ½ x 3 inch vanilla cardstock  
Strip of vanilla (for stamping flower and cut)  
6” piece of hemp (approx.)  
Always Artichoke ink pad  
Jumbo handle and cartridge inked Ballet blue  
Markers: So Saffron, Brocade Blue  
Cutter Kit (for distressing the edges

1. Fold the Kraft cardstock in half to form the card.
2. On the Brocade card ‘quarter’ roll the (pre-inked) jumbo wheel up the left side as shown in sample and adhere to the card front
3. On the vanilla rectangle, stamp the bold leaves in Artichoke as shown (twice) and then the outline leaves (matching as best you can—not a big deal if it doesn’t exactly line up
4. Distress the edge of the Kraft rectangle and adhere the vanilla cardstock to it. Tie a knot in hemp as shown and adhere it to card front
5. Take the ‘bold’ flower and ink the flower top only with the markers, starting with the yellow in the center and then the Brocade blue on the petals. Stamp this on the vanilla strip provided. Taking the blue marker again, ink the outline flower head and try to stamp it exactly on top of the first (bold) floral image (it may take one or two tries). Cut out the flower and adhere as shown with a pop dot.
